General Information

This application form is for international, local and non-award candidates for a postgraduate coursework program at the Faculty of Veterinary Science, University of Sydney.

Complete the application form using BLOCK LETTERS, and where required, place clear crosses in the appropriate boxes. Please ensure that the information on your application is complete, that all of the required documentation is included, and that the application is legible. Incomplete or illegible applications may be delayed.

Supporting Documentation

Original or certified copies of academic transcripts are required from *all applicants*, **unless** you graduated from the University of Sydney. Your academic transcript shows results of all study in the program – do not send your degree certificate without the transcript.

You may also need to attach other supporting documentation indicated in the application form. There is information on the application form about the circumstances under which you must provide documentation. **If you do not include all relevant documents it may delay the application process.**

Please try to provide original documents or certified copies of supporting documentation wherever possible, especially of academic documents such as transcripts and English proficiency results.

If your supporting documents are not in English you must provide official translated versions of those documents in addition to the originals or certified copies. Some examples of the types of translations which may be accepted are those produced by the Ethnic Affairs Commission (EAC), the Department of Immigration, Multicultural and Indigenous Affairs (DIMIA), or by an accredited National Accreditation Authority for Translators and Interpreters (NAATI) translator of at least 'Translator' or 'Level 3' status. Please note that if you are providing copies of translations, rather than originals, these copies must also be certified.
